Bolivia

During the services held at the ladies' prison in Cochabamba. six were baptized and five were filled with the Holy Spirit! Later, at the men's prison, thirty-three were baptized in Jesus' name! A local Bolivian pastor, Nicolas Felipe, travels constantly as a circuit preacher to several local towns and cities. With the Bible school students' help he set up the tent and had several revival services. As a result, six received the Holy Spirit and five were baptized in Jesus' name. A man named Feliciano was baptized at the Bible school; a 72-year-old man who speaks Quechua. The day he was baptized, he was in much pain suffering from shingles. His body was covered in blisters, and he had difficulty moving. The day after he was baptized, his shingles were gone and his skin had no evidence being blistered! His family was so impacted by his testimony that they wanted Pastor Nicolas to go to their home and have services! Family and friends

came from neighboring villages, filling a dump truck with thirty people. Brother Feliciano had started to build a large event hall behind his home to make money renting it out for weddings and parties. The contractor did not finish the job and the money ran out. In that building with just walls, a metal roof and a dirt floor. we had a weekend revival where five received the Holv Spirit and one was baptized in the freezing lake nearby! Great things are taking place in Bolivia, thanks to your prayers and giving!
